ATKINSON CEMETERY

Located on the road leading from West Minot to Auburn on the E.E. Atkinson farm. A neighborhood cemetery was established by the Atkinsons and others early in the 19th century. The enclosure borders the road on the easterly side, is about 200 feet square fenced in front with a picket fence painted, otherwise by a stone wall. The yard has a gradual slope easterly and has no shade trees. (Between Greenwood and Gilpatrick) (Visited Oct 17, 1904) JWP

\*Note - The picket fence was replaced by the Horace Moody family with the present metal mesh fence. In the right hand corner, next to the east stone wall, is a field stone lying on the ground and between two rough field head stones. Here lie Master Ebeneza Bray and his wife Judith (Bennett) Bray. Master Bray was deformed in feet and hands but taught school on Bradbury Hill in later life. They came to Minot in 1777. Ebenezer (1732-1817) and Judith, his wife, died in 1799, aged 66 years. The family lived on the road going to Minot Spring Farm, now a cellar hole, first place on the right starting from Woodman Hill Road. (Their son and wives have had stones in this cemetery.) SJC 1976
